All clients were screened in house, not eligible for Ride Line services, and needed a volunteer for 3-4 hours per week to help them age in place.

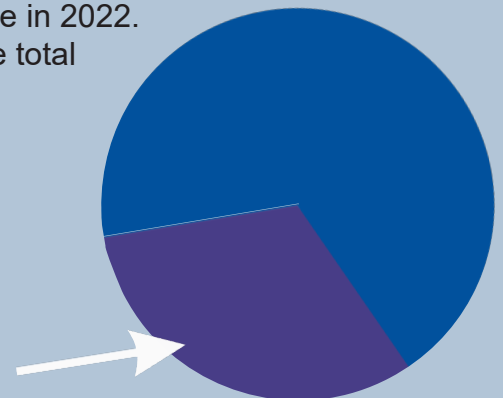
